It is recommended by the board of selectmen that cemetery by-laws be changed from “resident” to “property owner” being allowed to buy a plot before funds are given. It is also recommended by the board of selectman that the cemetery association go through an audit. An official letter to be written to the cemetery committee for consideration of funds if changes are considered.
